

Tap Water Tour

(8th - 12th grade)
2 class periods

Study drinking water properties, including pH, chlorine, iron, copper, hardness and nitrates with water samples coming from student's homes or the school. This lesson includes both lecture and provided laboratory experiments.

Grade Level Expectations in Science:
